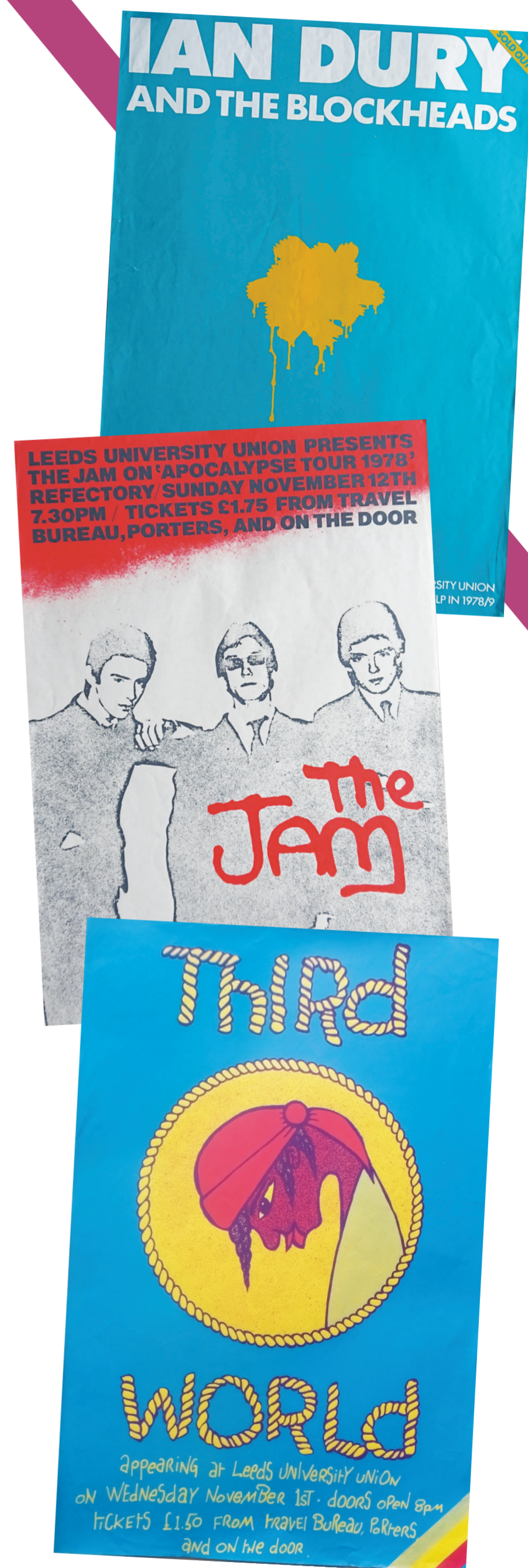

**There are many famous musicians and people in the music industry who have lived, worked or studied in Hyde Park and Woodhouse.**

The area was home to members of post-punk band Gang of Four, American singer Henry Rollins and DJs Liz and Andy Kershaw. Corinne Bailey Rae studied English at Leeds University and worked in the Clock Cafe at Hyde Park Corner, while Marc Almond and Dave Ball formed Soft Cell while studying at Leeds Polytechnic just down the road.

Thousands of bands have played gigs at local venues like Strawbs, The Packhorse, The Eldon and the Faversham as well as Leeds Beckett and the University of Leeds, which played host to iconic live performances by Bob Marley, The Who and Ian Dury, amongst many others.
